

LAW DAY

Law Day is a national day of recollection and this year is celebrated locally on May 1. Its purpose is to commemorate our liberties and invite a rededication of all citizens to the ideals of our democratic society: equality and justice under law.

Law Day was first established by Presidential proclamation in 1958, reaffirmed by a Joint Resolution of Congress in 1961. This year's theme is

**NO COURTS,
NO JUSTICE,
NO FREEDOM.**

The 2012 Law Day theme, "No Courts, No Justice, No Freedom," underscores the importance of the courts and their role in ensuring access to justice for all Americans.

"All of us must have and protect our right and our freedom to use courtrooms when we need to. That courtroom must be open to protect families. That courtroom must be open to validate and protect contracts for business. That courtroom must be open to keep the wheels of justice turning. That courtroom must be open to defend our individual rights to prove again and again that we continue to be a free society. All of that takes more money ... not less and less money for our courts."
